The General Data Protection Regulation (the GDPR) is due to become law on 25 May 2018. In this session Nicola will give an update on the current requirements for implementing this legislation.

“Emerging Risk Analytics”

Neil is a principal and consulting actuary with Milliman where he leads the development of Milliman's CRisALIS methodology for analysing and quantifying enterprise risk. Prior to joining Milliman, Neil spent 15 years working in the UK operation of a Top 10 insurance company in Europe. For five years, he sat on the company board and had executive responsibility for strategy, legal, compliance, projects, marketing, product development, public relations, mergers and acquisitions, finance, and risk management.

This session looks at a case study which uses advanced machine learning algorithms, such as deep neural networks, to analyse social media conversations about Brexit. The purpose of the study was to examine whether useful information could be extracted from social media in what is effectively real time on a key topic in a political economy.

“KIDs, SM&CR and other new regulatory requirements”

Barnett Waddingham is the UK’s largest independent provider of actuarial, administration and consultancy services. It was founded in 1989 and its business has grown predominantly through referrals from clients and professional contacts.

This session will provide an overview of recent regulatory announcements. We will look in detail at the new Key Information Documents (KIDs) for Packaged Retail and Insurance-based Investment Products (PRIIPs) Regulation and how it will affect the retail investment market. Our second topic is the extension of the Senior Managers and Certification Regime (SM&CR) to insurers, which strengthens individual accountability in insurance and replaces the current Approved Persons Regime. With consultation papers issued by both the PRA and FCA, this will change how people working in financial services are regulated.

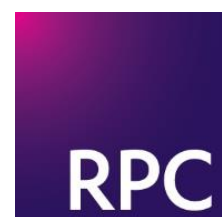
