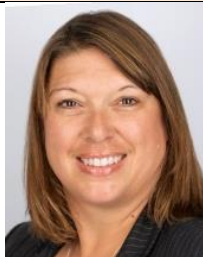
Welcome to the agenda for TWIN's next virtual meeting.

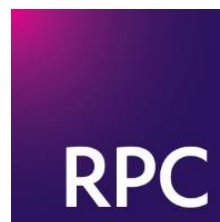
