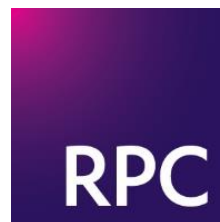
Karen, representing Flood Re, has a seat on TWIN’s Advisory Board. She will be moderating this panel session.
